OBJECTIVE OF THE COMPANY

Minimally invasive surgery is a method widely accepted worldwide and by surgeons and by patients. It is a technique of a future that does not have a rightful place in Croatia, so it is not included in undergraduate or postgraduate classes. Therefore, we consider that the education of gynecologists in this area is necessary, and therefore we decided to establish a society in the medical Choir which was immediately after the establishment approached the organization of the course from gynecological endoscopy.
